I am requesting funding for Hall Boulevard Safety and Active Transportation Improvements in the surface transportation reauthorization legislation.


The project sponsor for this project is the City of Tigard and the project is located at Hall Boulevard/OR Route 141 at Fanno Creek Trail, in Tigard, Oregon 97106.

The funding is designated for design and construction of an improved Fanno Creek Regional Trail roadway crossing, and two new pedestrian and bicycle bridges across Fanno Creek to support safe and comfortable travel separated from vehicles.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer dollars and is anticipated to have the following benefits: improved safety for all travel modes; reduced reliance on single occupancy vehicle travel; and improved access to public services through a mix of commercial, employment, and multi-family residential areas, including low-income housing.
