I am requesting funding for Safety and Smart Technology Investments: Central City, Broadway in the surface transportation reauthorization legislation.


The project sponsor for this project is the City of Portland and the project is located at NW/SW Broadway Street from SW Lincoln Street to NW Johnson Street, Portland, Oregon. The project includes the following ZIP Codes: 97209, 97205, and 97201.

The funding is designated for enhancing safety and improving transit speed and reliability from Southwest Lincoln Street to the Broadway Bridge. The Central City-Broadway project will bring safer crossings, new streetlights, a protected bikeway, and smart traffic signals enabling cross street bus efficiency improvements.
