## **Notice of Public Meeting and Comment Period** *Proposed Relocation of Forest Grove, OR, Post Office*

**What:** The U.S. Postal Service will host a public meeting for the Forest Grove Post Office located at 1822 21<sup>st</sup> Ave., Forest Grove, OR 97116.

**Background:** Due to the possibility that its lease on the Forest Grove Post Office location may be terminated, the U.S. Postal Service is now looking for an alternate location to relocate retail services to a yet-to-be-determined location.

The relocation project will consist of procuring a suitable substitute location, as close as reasonably possible to the existing location. Retail Services will continue at the current site or could be temporarily relocated to an existing facility until such time as all necessary preparations are completed at the new location.

Postal Service representatives will present the proposal for the relocation during the meeting.
