
Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for Americans with Disabilities Act Facility Upgrades in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is Tualatin Hills Park & Recreation District (THPRD), located at 15707 SW Walker Rd., Beaverton, Oregon 97006. The funding would be used for the completion of ADA upgrades at two recreation centers, one of which is designated for adults 55 years and older, and two swim centers. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will increase accessibility at four of THPRD's facilities for the more than 200,000 people who reside in Oregon's First Congressional District and THPRD's service area.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(5).
