I am requesting funding for Rock Creek Recycled Water Pump Station in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Clean Water Services, located at 2550 SW Hillsboro Hwy, Hillsboro, Oregon, 97123. The funding would be used to expand its recycled water system by building a pump station that will deliver treated wastewater from the Rock Creek facility to communities in western Washington County, including Forest Grove, Hillsboro, Banks, North Plains, and Cornelius. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will support watershed health while allowing the region to continue growing and building housing without relying on more costly and energy-intensive cooling systems at the treatment plant.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Title VI of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C 1381 et seq.
